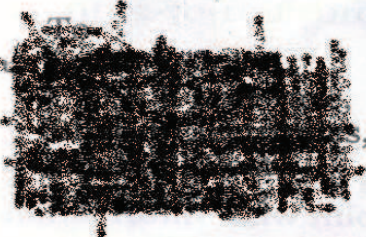
Please refer to your application, dt:6-06-2010, addressed to the Dir.Genl.of Police, A.P. Hyderabad requesting to provide certain information under RTI Act. Your application has been examined. The point wise information is furnished hereunder:

- 1) Generally during the investigation an offence of Sec. 498-A IPC the investigating officer will collect wedding cards, Photographs/ CDs of performance of marriage and engagement, in which the visuals of dowry giving and taking are available.
The investigation also includes the examination of witnesses/mediators, who have the knowledge of giving or taking of the dowry between the parties of both the bride and bride groom.
- 2) In investigation of offence Under Section 498-A IPC, the Investigation Officers will collect the receipts of articles and also verify the source of properties(Movable/Immovable)
- 3) The investigation in sec.498-A IPC cases, usually does not include verification of Incometax Returns filed by the complainant and their family member to verify the dowry claims.
- 4) In General the investigating officer, in such nature of cases, will collect extracts of bank transactions of both the parties for ascertainment of financial capacity and receipt of dowry bridegroom's party.
- 5) The Investigation Officer of Sec.498-A IPC cases will collect the list of Jehaz/Gift articles in case of complainant is of Muslim. Since the custom is not practice in other Religions/Communities, the collection of such list does not arise. Usually the list of presents/gifts is collected during the investigation i.e. after registration of FIR.

- 6) If the visual clippings, oral statements of the mediators manifest that the complainant's party voluntarily offers dowry to the bridegroom's party, then, the investigation officer will not hesitate even to book a case against the bride's party.


